Summary

Under the direction of the Service Manager, the ECE is responsible for providing child minding services to newcomer families who recently arrived in Canada.

Key Responsibilities

- Welcome and support both children and parents
- Provide a nurturing, positive, and supportive environment for all children
- Plan and implement fun indoor activities that meet the individual developmental needs and experiences of children who are younger than 13 years of age to guide their social, emotional, physical, and cognitive development
- Guide and assist children while eating, dressing, and using the toilet
- Help with diaper changing, if required
- Maintain daily records, including, but not limited to, the Attendance Forms, Pick-up/Drop-off Forms
- Set up and clean up children's play area before and after each session
- Document accidents, injuries, and serious occurrences, as needed
- Inspect the space for safety issues and consult with the Service Manager in order to arrange corrective action(s)
- Collaborate with staff members to create a positive environment in the room while parents are attending the workshops
- Provide first language services, as required, to enhance the client experience
- Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor

- Ability to lift infants/toddlers (maximum 25 kg or 55 pounds) when needed (for example, diapers change)
- Sensitivity to cultural, linguistic, and religious diversity
- Ability to continuously bend, squat, or move at a fast pace
- Participates in light program house duties and occasional room re-arrangements
- Fluency in a second language is an asset
- Good personality, ability, and temperament necessary to work with children
